

Math Word Problems Worksheet 1



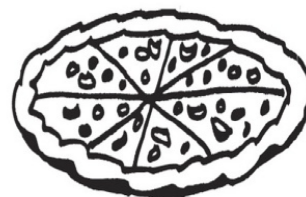

On Thursday, he put in 12. On Friday, he put in 33. On Saturday, he put in 10. On Sunday, he put in 3. How many does he have in his bag now?

Today, Jane and Kirra bought a rabbit from the pet shop for 20 dollars. They also bought a hutch for it to sleep in for 35 dollars. Just before they left, Jane grabbed a blue feeding bowl that cost \$3. On the way home from the pet shop, they stopped at a fruit and vegetable store and bought a bag of carrots for 2 dollars and 3 lettuces. The lettuces cost 1 dollar each. How much did Jane and Kirra spend on the rabbit?
