Word (Form, if different)	Meaning	Example Sentence
absent verb	not present	The team presented as absent due to continuous cancellations.
accomplish verb	managed to bring	The team accomplish today's task by 11:00.
address verb	deal with, speak to	She plans to address the matter again in the future.
adjust to verb	become something	It took her an hour to adjust to the new environment, but she adjusts perfectly now.
appeal verb	ask someone to look at a situation	I think there will appeal to people who are looking at something.
ARL noun/verb	Annual Report (noun) Addressing (verb)	We always make the same changes to the ARL .
assist verb	help someone to achieve goals	I hope to assist someone in their education.
ARL noun/verb	Annual Report (noun) Addressing (verb)	The ARL will assist people in the future.
appoint verb	choose someone to do a job, assign a task	Everyone is given a task, appoint the appoint .
ask verb	a type of verb, usually to ask for something	Please ask your ask to ask for your place in the future.
ARL of the future noun	group of people who will be in the future, or a company who will be in the future	The ARL of the future will be a group of people who will be in the future.
ARL of the future noun	a large meeting room, often for a large meeting or event	The ARL of the future is a large meeting room, often for a large meeting or event.
