


A WAR THAT CHANGED THE WORLD

2014 marks 100 years since the start of World War I, also known as The Great War. Draw a line from the important events listed at the bottom to their corresponding date on the timeline.



EVENTS

- The Treaty of Versailles officially ends WWI.
- The Battle of the Somme begins. This is the first battle where tanks are used.
 - During this month, Austria-Hungary declares war on Serbia and Russia; Germany declares war on France and Russia; the United Kingdom declares war on Germany; and the United States announces it will remain neutral.
 - U.S. President Woodrow Wilson issues the Fourteen Points Program.
 - The Battle of Verdun, the longest and bloodiest battle of WWI, begins.
- Germany signs the armistice and fighting ends on the 11th hour of this day.
- Archduke Franz Ferdinand, heir to Austria-Hungary's throne, is assassinated.
 - The Bolsheviks successfully overthrow the Russian government.
 - Germany declares a "war zone" around Great Britain and the Dardanelles Campaign begins.
 - The United States declares war on Germany.
